The Center is one of twenty around the state that play host to close to four million visitors each year. The Vermont Information Center Division’s mission is to promote the tourism industry and the Vermont businesses, attractions and events that reflect the Vermont experience.

High Beams designers Trenny Robb and Bob Michaud began in 1980 with Victorian Reproductions and restoration work. Now they are into the Arts and Crafts era and everything in between. All of their lampshades are made with real leaves and petals, mica, fabric, parchment and more. Using these materials makes their beautiful creations “one-of-a-kind” art. Galleries that feature High Beams lighting include: Cotswold Furniture Market in Stowe, Center Street Artisans Gallery in Rutland, the Woodstock Collective, Artisans Hand Craft Gallery in Montpelier and the NEK Artisan’s Guild.
